Attachment C

Special Provisions for IAC 15 Aerobatic Box

- 1. Aerobatic flight shall be confined to the areas designated on attachments A1 and B1 of the FAA Form 7711-2 application for certificate of waiver or authorization.
- 2. No aerobatic maneuvers may be performed over any open air assembly of persons or congested area of any city, town, or settlement.
- 3. No person may operate an aircraft in aerobatic flight when the visibility is less than 3 miles or a ceiling less than 3000 feet.
- 4. The IAC 15 president or its officers are authorized to activate and deactivate the aerobatic practice areas.
- 5. At least 24 hours prior to commencement of aerobatic flight operations within the waivered airspace, a responsible person shall advise IXD ATCT and file an eNOTAM (1me-notam.com) with Lockheed Martin Flight Services. At a minimum the NOTAM shall include the location, dates, and times that the aerobatic activity will be in effect.

Note: a copy of this waiver, including attachments, has been provided to Lockheed Martin Flight Services, IXD ATCT, and MCI ATCT.

- 6. Notification shall be made to the IXD ATCT at least 60 minutes before the commencement of aerobatic activity in the practice area, or, if a letter of agreement exists, notification shall be made as specified in that document. The IXD ATCT shall again be notified at the termination of aerobatic activities.
- 7. IAC 15 shall also be responsible for the following:
 - a. ensuring that all pilots and aircraft operating within the confines of the waivered aerobatic practice areas are properly certificated;
 - b. briefing each pilot to ensure that all users of the practice areas comply with the limitations associated with the certificate of waiver;
 - c. maintaining a log containing the pilot's name, airman certificate number, aircraft registration number, date and time the aerobatic practice was in use, and shall provide this information to the FAA upon request.
- 8. Radio communications procedures shall be in accordance with IAC 15 SOP, paragraph 10 (attachment D).

- 9. All pilots operating within the aerobatic practice area shall maintain VFR at all times and shall be responsible for seeing and avoiding all conflicting traffic.
- 10. Aerobatic flight shall be conducted only between the hours of sunrise and sunset.
- 11. IXD ATCT may interrupt and/or delay flight activity in the aerobatic box at any time due to handling requirements of local air traffic. Additionally, the holder of this certificate of waiver or a delegated representative is responsible for halting or canceling activity in the aerobatic practice area if, at any time, the safety of persons or property on the ground or in the air is in jeopardy, or if there is a failure to comply with the terms or conditions of this waiver.
- 12. The FAA has the authority to cancel the certificate of waiver or delay any activities if the safety of persons or property on the ground or in the air is in jeopardy, or if there is a violation of the terms of the waiver or authorization.

No certificate may be issued unless a completed application form has been received (14 C.F.R. 91, 101, and 105).

fighting equipment. The applicant may also wish to submit photographs and scale diagrams as supplemental material to assist in the FAA's evaluation of a particular site. Application for a Certificate of Waiver or Authorization must be submitted 45 days prior to the requested date of the event.

New Century AirCenter Airport Aerobatic Competition and Practice Area IAC 15 Standard Operating Procedures

The following are the current requirements for using the Aerobatic Box/Practice Area at the New Century AirCenter (KIXD):

1. Aerobatic flight shall be confined to the areas designated on the pictorial chart attached to this Certificate of Waiver and defined below:

Area A - Grev Shaded Area depicted in Attachment A1

The airspace extends from a north-south line defined by the east edge of Taxiway Alpha at the New Century AirCenter, east to a north-south line extending from Old Highway 56 to the north, along a section line defined partially by South Hedge Road, intersecting with 175th Street to the south. The north boundary of the airspace is defined by 151st Street; the south boundary is defined by 175th Street.

• Altitude from 1.500 ft. AGL (2,600 MSL) to 5,000 ft. AGL (6,100 MSL).

Area B – Red Shaded Area depicted in Attachment B1

The aerobatic practice and competition box at the New Century Airport (KIXD) is a box 3,650 ft. by 3,650 ft. located approximately 460 ft. east of Runway 18/36 and 800 ft. south of Taxiway Bravo.

• Altitude from surface to 5,000 ft. AGL (6,100 MSL).

- 2. The person authorized to activate and deactivate the aerobatic practice area is the President of the Kansas City Aerobatic Club, or his delegated representative.
- 3. A copy of this Certificate of Waiver must be provided to the Lockheed Martin Flight Service Station and the New Century AirCenter ATCT at least 48 hours prior to the initial aerobatic use of the waivered airspace. It should contain a request the Certificate of Waiver be kept on file for two years.
- 4. At least 24 hours before commencement of aerobatic flight operations a person authorized to activate and deactivate the aerobatic practice area shall advise the IXD ATCT and Lockheed Martin Flight Service Station by filing an e-NOTAM (Ime-notam.com) which includes the location, dates, and times the aerobatic activity will be in effect.

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- 5. The person authorized to activate the waiver, or their authorized delegate, shall:
 - a. Ensure all pilots and aircraft operating within the confines of the aerobatic practice area are properly certificated.
 - b. Ensure each pilot is briefed on the limitations imposed by the Certificate of Wavier and its Special Provisions.
 - c. Maintain a log containing the pilot's name, airman certificate number, aircraft registration number, date and time the aerobatic practice area was in use and provide this information to the FAA upon request.
 - d. Ensure notification of IXD ATCT at least 30 minutes prior to aerobatic activity commencing and at the termination of aerobatic activity.
- 6. Aerobatics are limited to those aircraft and pilots who are approved by the holder of the certificate of waiver or their designated representative in accordance with the prior provision.
- 7. No aerobatic maneuvers may be performed over any open-air assembly of persons or congested area of any city, town, or settlement. In particular, aerobatic flight in Area A shall not be conducted over the settlement of Clare (167th Street between Old 56 Hwy and I-35), or the extreme SW corner (McDonald's restaurant and State of Kansas maintenance facility).
- 8. No person may operate an aircraft in aerobatic flight when the visibility is less than 3 miles or the ceiling is less than 3,000 ft. AGL (4,100 MSL).
- 9. All pilots operating within the waivered airspace shall maintain VFR at all times and shall be responsible for seeing and avoiding all conflicting traffic.
- 10. All pilots operating within the waivered airspace shall be in two-way radio contract with either a safety observer on the ground or the New Century AirCenter ATCT. When a ground based safety observer is used, the safety observer shall monitor and coordinate ATCT communications with the pilot.
- 11. Aerobatic flight shall be conducted only between the hours of sunrise and sunset.
- 12. IXD ATCT may interrupt and/or delay activity in the aerobatic box at any time due to handling requirements of local air traffic. Additionally, the holder of this Certificate of Waiver, or his delegated representative, is responsible for halting or canceling activity in the waivered airspace if, at any time, the safety of persons or property on the ground or in the air is in jeopardy, or if there is a failure to comply with the terms or conditions of the waiver.
- 13. The FAA has the authority to cancel the Certificate of Waiver or delay any activities if the safety of persons or property on the ground or in the air is in jeopardy, or if there is a violation of the terms of the waiver or authorization.
- 14. All operations must be conducted in strict compliance with current NOTAMs, and/or any waivers to those NOTAMs, issued by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA).
